

Executive Summary: Hedge Fund Guided Portfolio Solution (“HFGPS”)

HFGPS is a single ticket allocation to a concentrated basket of world class global hedge funds created by GCM Grosvenor, aligned with Chief Investment Office (“CIO”)^{1,2,3} guidance. The Fund is made available to investors and provides 1099 tax reporting.

Firm Overview

- GCM Grosvenor is a global alternative asset management solutions provider. The Firm’s investment management and advisory services span public and private markets, focusing on absolute return strategies, credit, private equity, infrastructure and real estate. The Firm has specialized in alternatives for over 50 years and is dedicated to delivering value for clients by leveraging its cross-asset class and flexible investment platform.
- The Firm, incepted in May 1971, has assets under management (“AUM”) of \$97 billion⁴ and 554⁵ employees.

Fund Strategy

- The Fund’s investment objective is to seek absolute returns with low to moderate volatility and with minimal correlation to the global equity and fixed income markets while preserving capital.
- The Fund is a multi-strategy and concentrated portfolio of world class hedge funds that is adjusted dynamically as market conditions change and the investment opportunity set evolves.

Fund Differentiators

- Emphasizes exposure to difficult-to-access, persistent alpha generative⁶ and capacity constrained funds.
- Leverages lower fees obtained by GCM Grosvenor from its network of hedge funds.
- Seeks to complement and diversify exposure within a total portfolio.

Market Opportunity

- Hedged investment strategies serve an especially vital role in today’s market environment. The HFGPS strategy has resulted in improved performance after the volatility experienced in early 2022 with returns that have been less sensitive to extreme movements in stocks and bonds.
- GCM Grosvenor views the portfolio as a well-diversified roster of elite, high-performing and Alpha-oriented investment funds designed to withstand volatility and navigate various market environments.

Performance⁷

- HFGPS has delivered a net return of +7.3% year to date (“YTD”) 2026. Since inception in April 2019, HFGPS has generated a +3.9% annualized return with an annualized standard deviation of +6.0%.
- The Fund has aimed to maintain low sensitivity to global equities; beta since inception to the S&P 500 has been 0.25.
- The Fund has a +10.8% 1-year annualized net return, +4.7% 5-year annualized net return.

Definitions

Alpha (α) – Alpha is a term used in investing to describe an investment strategy’s ability to “beat” the market, or its “edge.” Alpha is thus also often referred to as excess return or the abnormal rate of return in relation to a benchmark, when adjusted for risk. Alpha, often considered the active return on an investment, gauges the performance of an investment against a market index or benchmark that is considered to represent the market’s movement as a whole. Alpha is used in finance as a measure of performance, indicating when a strategy, trader, or portfolio manager has managed to over or under perform in relation to the market return (or another benchmark) over some period. A positive alpha indicates the return on investment outperformed the benchmark rate on a risk-adjusted basis. A negative alpha indicates the return on investment underperformed compared to the benchmark index.

Annualized - An annualized statistic has been normalized to a 12-month equivalent. This is accomplished by taking the geometric monthly average return to the twelfth power.

Beta - Beta measures an investment’s volatility versus a market index. It represents the systematic or market-driven risk of an investment. Beta may be positive, negative or zero. An investment with a positive beta tends to move in the same direction as the index; an investment with a negative beta tends to move in the opposite direction. Further, an investment with a beta greater than 1 (in absolute value) is more volatile than the index. An investment with a beta of 2, for example, is twice as volatile as the index. An investment with a beta less than 1 (in absolute value) is less volatile than the market index. The formula for Beta is:

Standard & Poor’s (“S&P”) 500 Index - The S&P 500 Index is a capitalization-weighted index designed to measure the performance of the U.S. economy through changes in the market value of stocks representing major industries. Shares rebalanced quarterly. Constituent changes made as needed. Total returns reported. Material differences include risk profile of comparable investment and liquidity.

Standard Deviation (StdDev) (σ) - Standard Deviation is a statistical measure of a variable’s dispersion around the mean. It is often used as a measure of investment risk. The formula for the Standard Deviation of a population of data is:
